GENERAL UNIFORM REMINDERS

☉ Hair Accessories and styles

Long hair should be tied back for school for health and safety reasons. Plain hair bands and bobbles should be worn to school. Large bows and colourful hairbands are not suitable, save these for Christmas party day! We would also ask that hair is neat and tidy and not an extreme style.

☉ Uniform and PE kit

Please make sure children bring appropriate outdoor clothing to school, ie coats, hats, gloves etc. PE kits should be in school colours (sky blue t-shirt, navy jogging bottoms and maroon hoody). Please note that children should wear flat, black, polishable shoes for school, not boots or trainers. Trainers should only be worn on their PE days. ***Please make sure that any item of clothing brought in to school is labelled with your child's name - this makes it much easier to find any lost items.***
