Writing:

- ⇒ Using varied sentence lengths
- ⇒ Using different verb forms
- ⇒ Creating atmosphere
- write effectively for a range of purposes and audiences, selecting language that shows good awareness of the reader (e.g. the use of the first person in a diary; direct address in instructions and persuasive writing)
- in narratives, describe settings, characters and atmosphere
- using co-ordinating and subordinating conjunctions
- integrate dialogue in narratives to convey character and advance the action
- select vocabulary and grammatical structures that reflect what the writing requires, doing this mostly appropriately (e.g. using contracted forms in dialogues in narrative; using passive verbs to affect how information is presented; using modal verbs to suggest degrees of possibility)
- use a range of devices to build cohesion (e.g. conjunctions, adverbials of time and place, pronouns, synonyms) within and across paragraphs
- use verb tenses consistently and correctly throughout their writing including a range of: active, passive, modal and subjunctive verbs mostly appropriately
- spelling most words correctly* (year 5 and 6) and use a dictionary to check the spelling of uncommon or more ambitious vocabulary
- maintain legibility in joined handwriting
