LEAVE OF ABSENCE DURING TERM TIME

Leave of absence forms must be completed before children are taken out of school.

All leave of absence requests during term time will be **unauthorised**. We understand that there may be exceptional circumstances that require a child to be absent, but it is crucial to emphasise the importance of regular attendance for the educational progress of our pupils. If the leave of absence request is for an exceptional circumstance, you would need to provide appropriate documentation or evidence to support this. Whilst we cannot guarantee that these requests will be authorised, each case will be carefully considered on an individual basis.
