To login you will need to enter your name and your child's name ([First Name] [Last Name]). The login details you enter must match those we have on record for you. Appointments will be available to book from 3:30 pm on 11th Oct 2024 until 3:00 pm on 25th Oct 2024. After you have made your appointments you can choose to print or e-mail confirmation. The email address field on the login page is only used to send your appointment confirmation. If you have problems logging in, it will not be because of the e-mail address you entered.

In the news this week

E-commerce company, Amazon, has told all staff they need to return to the office five days a week next year, ending the option to work from home. In a message to all workers, Chief Executive Andy Jassy said the company expected everyone to be in the office full time (apart from some exceptions) from 2nd January, 2025. Amazon's new policy is very different from the UK government's approach, which is to make flexible working a right for employees, as promised in a new law proposal, due to be announced later this year.
